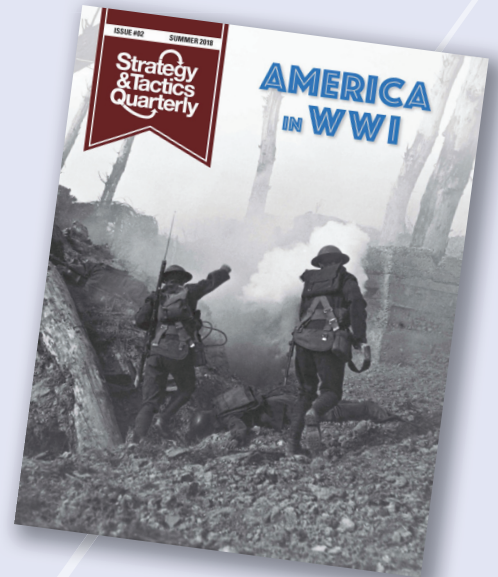
## AMERICA IN WORLD WAR I

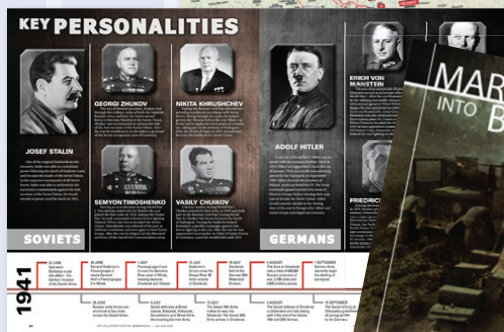
