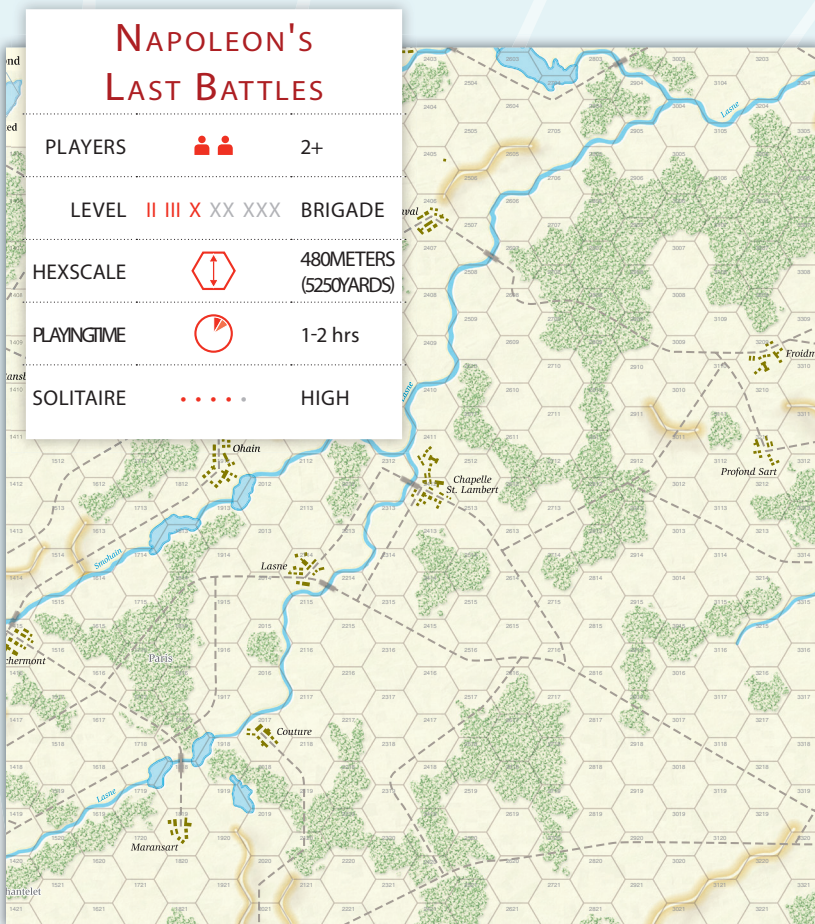




Napoleon's Last Battles

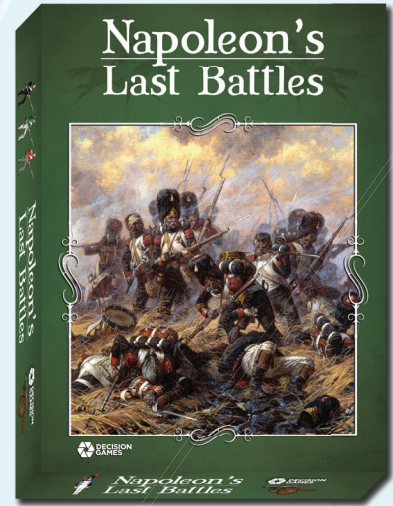
Napoleon's escape from Elba in early 1815 touched off a new European war. A French preemptive strike into Belgium led to a chaotic four-day campaign that historically ended at Waterloo. It might have gone differently. This game, an update of the SPI original and the 1995 DG reprint, allows players to recreate the entire campaign, or to fight each of the four principal battles fought historically: Ligny, Quatre Bras, Wavre, and Waterloo (or La Belle Alliance). Other scenarios include a pair of one-day mini campaigns and a Wavre variant. Additional units make potential reinforcements available, or modify the original order of battle to incorporate new research, or give players the means to alter each army's countermix. Optional rules present variants for several of the standard rules.
